Reflections from Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

Meditation: I went across the garden one afternoon and stopped on the shore of the lake; I stood there for a long time, contemplating my surroundings. Suddenly, I saw the Lord Jesus near me, and He graciously said to me, ***All this I created for you, My spouse; and know that all this beauty is nothing compared to what I have prepared for you in eternity*** (Diary, 158). "You know very well, O Jesus, that I am constantly swooning because of my longing for You." ***Know this, My daughter, that you are already tasting now what other souls will obtain only in eternity*** (Diary, 969).


