November 5th Collection was \$4,202.00 (**Budgeted \$4,442.30**) Immaculate Conception = \$3,991.20; St. Michael's = \$327.00; Sacred Heart = \$364.00 & Capital Campaign = \$4,354.33 Thank you for your continued support. Reflections from Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska
